Re: Food Conspiracy Co-op Response, COVID 19 (Coronavirus)

Our Management Team is monitoring guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Pima County Health Department to help inform our decisions on a daily basis.

In preparing for a continuance of the COVID 19 outbreak, we have decided to take the following precautionary measures:

- We are changing our store hours to **9 AM to 7 PM**. We will remain open 7 days per week. This will allow our Staff to clean and stock the store.
- We have transitioned our hot and salad bar to grab and go. We are discontinuing all self-serve/high-touch services in the store including bulk and coffee service.

Our Staff is committed to diligently sanitizing the store and work areas in regular intervals per hour as well as maintaining constant hand washing and hand sanitizer use. We also have a professional cleaning company that diligently sanitizes the store afterhours.

We will remain in close contact with our distributors to maintain our stock of grocery staples and fresh produce. We ask that you please only buy what you need so as to help us provide food to other folks in need.

Our Co-op is approaching this crisis from a place of strength and determination. We are here and we are committed to providing you the highest quality food throughout the trying time ahead of us.
